

EXETER

he story of the city goes back to pre-Roman times and, despite being bombed heavily during the Second World War, much of that history is still there to be experienced.

There are fascinating attractions, like its unique underground passages, free Red Coat guided tours to go on, the remains of an imposing Roman wall and an historic Quayside. You can learn more about the history of Exeter in the award-winning Royal Albert Memorial Museum and get a grandstand view of the city from our open-top Discover Exeter bus tour - it runs hourly and you can just hop on and off wherever takes your fancy. The route is shown below.

Perhaps Exeter's crowning glory is its magnificent cathedral with a breathtaking vaulted nave that is poetry in stone. The Cathedral Green surrounding it is a peaceful oasis in this busy city.

Exeter has excellent shopping with many favourite High Street names, but head to the West Quarter or the cobbled Gandy Street to discover some great independent cafés.


